INTERNATIONAL HOUSE,CHICAGO. MARCH 28,1970  
1:30--4:30PM

A total of twenty-eight Alumni were present. The breakdown of the figure according to the states are as follows: Illinois-19, Michigan-3, Indiana-2, Tennessee-1, Minnesota-1, Iowa-1, Pennsylvania-1.

Sumit Roy proposed that Subrata Bhattacharyya chair the meeting. Dipak Bagchi seconded the motion. The tragic death of Bandana Ganguly (65 Elec.) in a recent automobile accident near Boston was made known to the members by the Chairman. A one-minute period of silence was observed for the deceased. The Chairman then summarized the inception of the idea of an Alumni Association in America, the rationale behind it and the organizational work that has been performed by the Convenors to-date. A period of general discussion and comments then followed, all endorsing the usefulness of such an Association. The proposed draft constitution was then taken up for discussion and was approved by the majority vote of the members present with additions and alterations as required.

The meeting was adjourned for coffee. Election of Officers for the first Executive Committee of the Association followed next. The following members were elected unanimously to the Executive Committee for the next two years:

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The B.E.College Alumni Association of America is one year old today and to celebrate this event we have gathered here for our Second Annual Reunion. The first year of a newborn is always the most difficult period and the Association is no exception.

During the first year, the Association had undertaken the following tasks:

- (1) The draft Constitution was circulated and unanimously adopted.
- (2) A Loan Fund was created and the money kept in a bank.
- (3) Information regarding registration of the Association was collected but the actual registration (either as a 'for profit' or as a 'non-profit') deferred for financial reasons.
- (4) Area Representatives have been selected and informed.

During the last year a very large number of Alumni has migrated to USA and the total number of Alumni in our files has increased from 136 to 228.

We are very happy that the Alumni in the Detroit area took the initiative to hold the Second Annual Reunion in Detroit. We hope next year another industrial center having a large Alumni population will come forward to hold the next Annual Reunion.

The Executive Committee, in this period, had sent out several letters and communications to some 200 Alumni each time. Printing and mailing charges are heavy and increasing and contributions barely meet the general expenses. We urge all Alumni to be little more generous and those who have yet to contribute may do so at the earliest.

Recently we have received minutes of meetings held by Alumni from New York area expressing the wish of forming an Association covering several Eastern states of USA. We hope that this would become a chapter of the parent body.

On behalf of the President and the Executive Committee I extend my sincere thanks and appreciations to all Alumni for their cooperation and help, and we hope that continuing cooperation will be forthcoming in the future from all Alumni to make their Association a success.

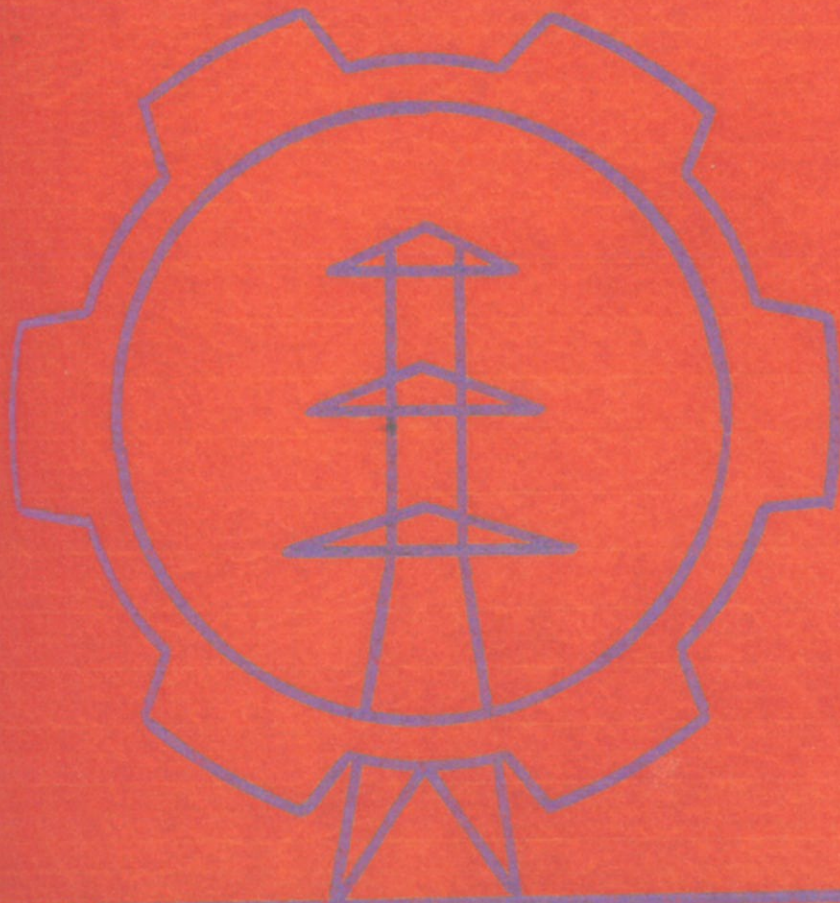

MINUTES OF THE MEETING: FOURTH ANNUAL REUNION  
CLEVELAND, OHIO. MAY 27, 1973

3. The nominating committee for the next Executive Committee should note that in future one member-at-large be selected from Canada. (Proposed by Anupam Bagchi, seconded by Sumit Roy).
4. The Executive Committee be given the power to set up and establish a charter for a standing committee to administer the Scholarship fund. The following slate was proposed and shall be investigated by the Executive Committee: "Immediate past and present Presidents and the present Treasurer are ex-officio members of this committee and two permanent members from the same location. (Proposed by Sumit Roy, seconded by S. Bhattacharrya.)
5. The names of the contributors towards the Scholarship Fund (without mentioning the amount) shall be published in the next brochure. (Proposed by Sumit Roy, seconded by Pranab Raychowdhury).
